#### GTCW Headteacher Data Analysis – August 2013

#### Data taken from the Register of Qualified Teachers on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2013

The data is split into two sections:

- section 1 tables analysing single date fields
- section 2 cross tabulation analysing more than one data field

#### Notes

- All data provided relates to "registered teachers" and the numbers are displayed as "actuals" rather than "full-time equivalents";
- The number of registered teachers is "real time" and can go up or down, depending on new registrations and de-registrations.
- The data is based on the first employment record held regardless of the number of employment records a teacher may have;
- There is no legal obligation for headteachers, teachers, schools or LAs to notify GTCW of changes for teaching staff within a school or their personal information on the Register.

#### **Key Findings**

- The number of headteachers who are registered with GTCW has fallen annually since the Annual Statistics Digest was introduced. This is explained by
  the reduction in the number of schools in Wales and increasingly headteachers covering more than one school particularly in rural areas. As at the 1<sup>st</sup>
  March 2013, 60 (3.7%) registered headteachers covered two or more schools;
- The number of female headteachers has increased annually over the last 10 years. However, if one considers that 75% of all registered teachers in Wales are female compared to 57% of all headteachers there remains an underrepresentation of female headteachers in Wales. This is particularly apparent in the secondary sector where only 29.6% of headteachers are female;
- 0.2% of registered headteachers have declared a disability compared to 0.3% of the total number of Registrants. Given that approximately 8% of the UK population have declared a disability it suggests that the number of registered headteachers with a disability appears to be under represented on the Register;
- 12.4% of all registered teaches have failed to make a declaration regarding their ethnicity. This is higher for registered headteachers (24.2%) although the
  number unknown is reducing each year. Of those headteachers who have made a declaration, 97% have described themselves as either White:British or
  White:Any other white background. This percentage correlates with the overall number of registered teachers where the same percentage (97%) have
  declared their ethnicity as White:British or White:Any other white background;
- The percentage of Welsh speaking headteachers (42%) is notably higher than the percentage of all registered teachers (32.5%) and deputy and assistant headteachers (33%) and considerably higher that the 19% national figure shown in the 2011 Census. This trend is mirrored when considering those headteachers who have declared that they are able to teach through the medium of Welsh (37.2%) compared to all registered teachers (27%) and deputy and assistant headteachers (27%);
- The age profile of headteachers is improving in that heads are getting younger. This improvement is particularly apparent in the primary phase. Interestingly, this pattern is not evident in "other school settings", such as special schools and pupil referral units;





March 2013 - Number of Teachers






