

**An analysis of teachers who gained Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) by completing the Graduate Teacher Programme (GTP) in Wales between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012**

**Notes**

- The data relates to those teachers who gained QTS by completing the GTP between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012;
- Where data relating to registered teachers is shown it should be noted that the numbers are displayed as “actuals” rather than “full-time equivalents”;
- The number of registered teachers is as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012 and is “real time.” The number can go up or down, depending on new registrations and de-registrations;
- The data relating to qualifications for each student has been provided by the appointed GTP assessor for each ITT Centre and has not been verified by the GTCW;
- There may be a number of teachers who gained QTS in Wales but who choose to work in a another country e.g. England.
- In table 2, supply teachers are only counted once regardless of the number of LAs or private supply teaching agencies they may work for.
