

The General Teaching Council for Wales (GTCW)
An Analysis of teachers who trained in Wales gaining Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) on 1st August 2007 and their current employment description 5 years after qualification

Data taken from the Register of Qualified Teachers on 11th December 2012

Notes:-

- Not all NQTs who qualify at a welsh institution go on to register with the GTCW. Some may go to another country or take time out before commencing their careers
 - There are a number of NQTs working in Wales who qualified in England but they are not included in the data shown;
 - Where registered teacher numbers are provided, the number represents “actuals” and not “full-time equivalents”;
 - Supply teachers are counted only once regardless of the number of Agencies or LAs they may undertake work for;
- The number of registered teachers is “real-time” and can go up and down depending on new registrations and de-registrations
